CORVETTES OF WA would like to invite members and guests, to the 2018 Corvette Convention, to come on an escorted 4 day road trip to see some of our great southern parts of Western Australia.

The road trip will take you to Margaret River to see our wonderful wineries and boutiques, and cruising through some of our best karri and tuart forests, stopping to see the Gloucester Tree. This is a giant karri tree in the Gloucester National Park. At 72 metres in height, it is the world's second tallest fire lookout tree.

From there we will travel to Denmark and visit the Tree Top Walk and experience the excitement of walking 40 metres high through the canopy, and enjoying the majestic views, of the tingle Forest.

The next stop will be Albany, to the award winning National Anzac Centre. The centre overlooks the actual harbour from which over 41,000 men and women departed Australia for the Great War.
