

Richard's 1961 Corvette



Bought in 1968, I am the second owner.
Numbers matching 283cu. 270 hp engine with Factory original dual 4 barrel carburetors, solid lifters, and high rise cam.



It carries it's white 'cloth top' and I have the hard top too. The car came with the rare option required in California RPO 242 crankcase ventilation, but without seat belts.



Chevrolet advertised a top speed of 140 mph. I have no doubt the car is capable, but with the 6.70-15- 4 ply tyres having only 51/2" of tread on the ground, and drum brakes; steering it and stopping it make that sort of speed risky.
