GENERAL BUSINESS:

COWA cabinet at Whiteman Park Museum needs updating. If anyone has suggestions or items to donate, please contact the committee to discuss.

Nationals Convention – This has been offered to WA.

- We have 21 months to get this event organised if we are to host.
- 2018 the club had 25 eastern states entrants and a total of 62 entrants.
- Darryl raised a concern of limited support from the East. Danny suggested that more commitment from the East would be needed if the event ran for more than 3 days.
- SA indicating around 10 entrants.
- A subcommittee over seen by the regular committee needs to be set up if we are to go ahead.
- 5 volunteers for a national’s subcommittee were gathered with others offering to help closer to the event.
- It was suggested NCRS be approached to put one committee member on the subcommittee for the event. Some members had concern with this. To be decided by the sub committee.

- Majority at the meeting showed hands that they would participate as entrants in the event.
- \$580 entrance fee at Ballarat this year. It was discussed that the convention must be arranged to be at the least a break event. It can't cost the club money. Many showed a desire to have the event achieve a profit as in previous years.
- Motion proposed by Andy Weatherburn that COWA decline or accept the 2025 convention. A unanimous vote in favour of hosting the National Convention in WA occurred. A sub committee is to be formed from members volunteering and a meeting date to be set.
- National convention suggested date is two weeks prior to easter 2025.

Weekend away – no one is arranging at this stage. Darryl suggested staying at Pingelly Exchange hotel and members can all participate in an event nearby. Darryl will investigate and advise.

Craig advised he will step down as the secretary at the next annual meeting. If you would like to nominate for the position, please contact a committee member.
